The MevaPress range of wastewater processing equipment is designed to process screenings such as toilet paper, wipes etc. Treating the screenings by washing and compacting, the organic contents will be dissolved from fibrous material and returned to the biological process to extend biogas production. The decreased organic content and the increased dry solids enable treated screenings to be a source for incineration, generating thermal energy for use in various processes. MevaPress SWP and the MevaPress CPS work together to maximize dry solids content and to minimize volume, which reduce the cost of screenings disposal. Combined with a MevaScreen solution, they provide excellent primary treatment for wastewater plants:

- Breweries




How MevaPress works

MevaPress SWP delivers washing and dewatering of screenings in a compact and cost-effective package. Combined with MevaPress CPS, the system can achieve a dry solids content of 45-60%. It is also possible to specify a long conveyor section to reach storage skips or hoppers for an efficient transport process.

The high counter pressure offered by the MevaPress CPS ensures an optimized retention time in the press zone, which provides a greater dewatering effect. This reduces the organic content of the screenings, an important factor when it comes to disposal.

To ensure operators can achieve maximum capacity, the MevaPress CPS series has a wide range of sizes. In fact, this system currently offers the largest capacity of any counter screw equipment on the market.



How MevaPress CPS/CPS-X works

MevaPress CPS/CPS-X is designed to extend the retention time of the screenings and maximize the washing effect. The screw creates a counter pressure against the screenings to optimize the dewatering process making the shredded material optimal for incineration. Pressure within the screw is continuously adjusted to maximize the dry solids content.

The shafted screw design allows discharge heights up to 7 meters with an inclination up to 85°, which is a far higher elevation than is possible with conventional press pipe systems.


